

## Acceptance Requirements

1. Iraqi nationality
2. Holder of an Iraqi Preparatory School Certificate, supported by the approval of the General Directorate of Education in Preservation or an equivalent certificate.
3. The student must be from 1995 onwards.
4. Pass the medical examination according to the conditions for each study, and the blind student will be presented, in which the conditions for submission of appropriate human studies are met) by central admission.
5. He is free to study and it is not permissible to combine a job and study (at the same time) in colleges and institutes. This includes employees of all government institutions, and it is stipulated that they continue their studies Obtaining a study leave from their departments, starting in accordance with the instructions in force, and it is not permissible to combine. Between two studies as well, and in case it is proven otherwise, he writes to the Ministry to cancel his acceptance. The employee student postpones studies according to the instructions in order to fulfill the condition of completing two years of service satisfactory to be entitled to obtain the study leave and in accordance with the instructions for granting the study leave
6. For alumni:
  - a. The current academic year.
  - b. The previous academic year of those who were not accepted as centrally accepted in any college or institute, and they are accepted, Their acceptance is according to the minimum limits for the year of their graduation and in the event that the student has been accepted in any of the A college or institute is returned to its original acceptance, and a failing year is considered against him.
7. Non-Iraqi students who hold an Iraqi preparatory certificate and who are accepted centrally are notifiedIn writing, reviewing the Central Admission Department / Expatriates Division to indicate their exemption or their demand for wages Academic studies in foreign currency, according to the regulations set out in Chapter VII.
